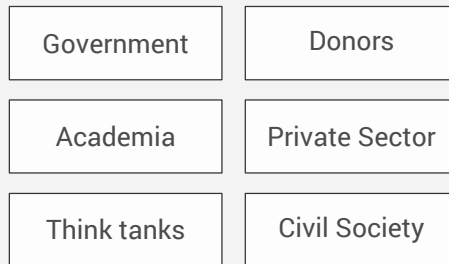
We want to give tailwind to good ideas and headwind to bad ones.

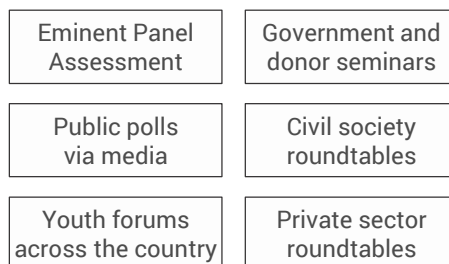
